The same is true for the music industry or the Kpop industry, where each music video is show-stopping and the music is so catchy that you don't need to know the language to enjoy the music.


This says a lot about how globally-loved this industry is. And South Korean variety shows are not only interviews but also fun activities show that can be a fun thing to watch on family nights.
